Extended School Day

You may recall that I wrote to you last term advising you of the adjustments being made to the school day in January. The Department for Education (DfE) has directed all schools from September 2024 to ensure school is open for all children for 32.5 hours each week. The Key Stage Two department already complied with this. However, in order to allow parents the time to pick children up in both departments, the infant department started five minutes later and finished five minutes earlier. In order to comply with the DfE

directive, the Early Years and KS1 day has now been extended. As the school has a large footprint, we have maintained the same arrangements of a five minute window at the start and end of each day. Unfortunately, in order to facilitate this, tweaks have had to be made to the school day in both departments. I realise that this may have caused inconvenience, which is why we informed you of the changes in November, but I hope you understand that these changes are necessary in order to meet government guidelines. Thank you for bearing with us whilst these changes are embedded.
